Subject: Filling up of 05 (five) vacancies of Additional District and Sessions Judges, under rule 6(1)(b) of the Haryana Superior Judicial Service Rules, 2007 in the State of Haryana.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to address you on the above-mentioned subject and to say that it has been decided to fill up 05 (five) vacancies, by promotion strictly on the basis of merit through Limited Competitive Examination, in the cadre of Additional District and Sessions Judges in the State of Haryana, under Rule 6(1)(b) of the Haryana Superior Judicial Service Rules, 2007. The selection will be made on the basis of the result of the Competitive Written Examination; Viva-voce; Assessment of Record; Annual Confidential Reports of the preceding 5 years and judgments of the cases decided by the officer during the preceding three years.

All the officers, who have put in 5 years of service as Additional Civil Judge(Senior Division)/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Civil Judge(Senior Division) and are not less than 35 years of age as on **28.10.2013** are eligible to compete. Any officer having been graded as "C-Integrity Doubtful", in any year shall not be eligible to appear.

The examination shall consist of three papers i.e. Civil Law-I, Civil Law II and Criminal Law. The syllabus for the aforesaid papers shall be the same as has already been notified in the Haryana Superior Judicial service Examination-2013 by way of direct recruitment from the Bar which is available

on the official website of this Court. The candidates who secure 50% or more marks in the aggregate of the written examination shall be entitled to be called for the interview. Only those candidates will be eligible for appointment who secure 60% marks in aggregate of the written examination and viva voce. The High Court reserves the right to invite candidates equivalent to three times of the number of vacancies for the viva voce. There shall be no revaluation of the papers of the written examination. However, rechecking of the answer sheets shall be allowed within fifteen days from the publication of the result on payment of ₹100/- per paper. The dates of the main written examination will be notified in due course.

The officers coming to appear in the written examination and the viva voce shall be treated on duty and they shall also be entitled to TA/DA as admissible under rules.

You are therefore, requested to forward the applications of all the officers willing to appear in the Limited Competitive Examination at the earliest but not later than **28.10.2013**. You may send advance copies through FAX.
