Suit for Declaration to the effect that Jain alias Jaina son of Shri Matu Ram who was predecessor in interest of the plaintiffs has not been heard or seen for the last about 7 years by those who have usually and generally seen him or heard of him and as per presumption of law as provided under the Indian Evidence Act, Jain alias Jaina son of Shri Matu Ram aforesaid has presumably died a civil death and accordingly after the civil death of Jain alias Jaina, the plaintiffs being the only legal heirs of him have become the absolute and undisputed owners in cultivating possession, in equal shares of land measuring one fourth share of land measuring 128 Kanals 3 Marlas comprising Khewat No. 355 334, Khatuni No. 402, one fourth share of land measuring 95 Kanals 4 Marlas comprising Khewat No. 356 335, Khatuni No. 403 and one fifth share of land measuring 39 Kanals 2 Marlas comprising Khewat No. 357 336, Khatuni No. 404 situated at village Puthi Mangal Khan, Tehsil Hansi, District Hisar as per Fard Jamabandi for the year 2019 2020 and the plaintiffs are legally and lawfully entitled to get recorded incorporated their names as owners in possession of the above land as well as all other lands and immovable properties as well as movable properties held in the name of Jain alias Jaina son of Shri Matu Ram of whatever type pursuant to his civil death and with mandatory injunction and direction to all concerned revenue offices Banks institutes etc. to transfer any other movable and immovable properties of Jain alias Jaina son of Shri Matu Ram in favour of the plaintiffs owing to his civil death. On the basis of evidence of all kinds oral as well as documentary of every description.
