Appeal against judgment and decree dated 08.08.2019 passed in Civil suit no 496/2005 date of institution 16.11.2018 CIS No. CS/899/2018 passed by Ms Sarvapreet Kaur, Civil Judge Jr. Divn. Sub Division Safidon by which suit of the plaintiffs has been decreed partly for specific performance of agreement to sell dated 23.04.2002 and defendants no 1 and 2 have been directed to execute and get registered the sale deed in favour of plaintiffs in terms of agreement to sell dated 23.04.2002 for the land measuring 91 kanal 3 marla out of khewat no 2 khatoni no 2 on receipt of balance sale consideration from plaintiffs with in a period of four months from the date of judgment and decree dated 08.08.2019 and if the defendants no 1 and 2 fail to execute the sale deed with in stipulated time of four months then balance sale consideration will be deposited by the plaintiff in the Court with in next month and plaintiffs shall be entitled to get the sale deed executed in their favour through process of Court and if the defendant no 2 has actually paid a sum of Rs 24,00,000/- to defendant no 1 for acquiring his share in his favour then defendant no 2 shall be entitled to receive this amount from balance sale consideration and the suit of plaintiffs qua the claim of land measuring 40 kanal of khewat no 3 khatoni no 50 has been dismissed being the defendant not remained owner of suit land by virtue of decree dated 22.12.2007 in civil suit no. 137 dated 12.12.2000. For setting aside judgment and decree dated 08.08.2019 by accepting the appeal of the appellant and dismissing the suit of the plaintiffs against defendants with costs throughout.
