Suit for Declaration to the effect that Roop Ram son of Shri Dalsukh Rai is presumed to be a dead person, as the whereabouts of the said Roop Ram son of Shri Dalsukh Rai is not known to anybody and he has not been found/searched out at any place dead and as he being not heard and traceable since April, 1970 i.e for the last more than 48years hence he is declared as a dead person according to the relevant provisions of Section 108 of Indian Evidence Act with the consequential relief that the plaintiffs and proforma defendants being the sons and daughters are the legal heirs of the presumed deceased Roop Ram son of Shri Dalsukh Rai, have become the owners in possession in equal shares i.e 1/5 share each of the estates left by the deceased whatsoever and situated Gali Moman Namberdar Wali, Bhadra Bazar, Sirsa or any where throughout the India including the movable properties if any in the name of deceased Roop Ram son of Shri Dalsukh Rai and hence the plaintiffs and proforma defendants are entitled to deal with the estates and can furnish any kind of undertaking and conduct the proceedings as was to be furnished by Roop Ram son of Shri Dalsukh Rai now presumed as deceased and the plaintiffs and proforma defendants are legally entitled to present themselves in the capacity as Roop Ram son of Shri Dalsukh Rai, as he (Roop Ram) has been declared as dead in legal sense, on the basis of evidence of every description oral as well as documentary.
