Petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, 1956 for declaring the petitioner as guardian of person of his brother namely Sultan son of Shri Ram Dayal, aged about 58 years who is man of Unsound mind and Insane person /suffering from incurable mental disease and also to act as guardian of him(Sultan)in respect of the property measuring -

i) 95/501.share out of land measuring 75 Kanal 03 marla comprised in khewat No.121/98 Khatauni No.134 Sq. No.15 Killa No.5/2/2(1-15),6/1(0-5), Sq.No.18 Killa No.11/2(7-12), 12/1(4-0), 19/2(4-0), 20/1(7-12), Sq. No.19 Killa No.15(8-0) 16(8-0) Sq. No.79 Killa No.19(8-0), 20(8-0), 21(8-0), 22/1(7-19), Sq. ii) 257/1307 share out of land measuring 65 Kanal 7 marla comprised in Sq. No.85 Killa No.1(8-0), 2(8-0), 3(8-0), 4(8-0), 7(8-0),8(8-0), 9(8-0), 10(8-0), 11/1 (1-7) vide khewat No.290 Khatauni No.319

And for all means with the consequential relief of Permanent Injunction restraining the respondents specially the respondents no.2 and 3 from alienating the respective share of unsound/mentally disabled person sultan by any means/mode on the basis of any documents bearing the alleged signature of Sutan and also from doing any act qua the suit properties on the basis of any manipulated signed papers of Sultan and also for issuance of Injunction restraining the General public from getting transfer the properties of Sultan in the name of anybody else except by getting first permission from the competent Court of law, on the basis of evidence of every description oral as well as documentary.

Whereas it has been proved to the satisfaction of the Court that the defendant No. 3 above named cannot be served in the ordinary way of service. Hence, this proclamation under order 5 Rule 20 CPC is hereby issued against him/them and should appear personally or through their counsel on 13-04-2018 at 9.30 a.m.

Take notice that, in default of his/their appearance on the day before mentioned, the above said case will be heard and determined in his/their absence.
