Suit for Declaration to the effect that Gurdayal Singh son of Shri Kishan Singh resident of Village Mangala Tehsil and District Sirsa, is presumed to be a dead person, as the whereabouts of the said Gurdayal Singh is not known to anybody and he has not been found/searched out at any place presumed to be dead and as he being not heard and traceable for the last more than 7 years i.e since 2005, hence he is declared as a dead person according to the relevant provisions of Section 108 of Indian Evidence Act with the consequential relief that the plaintiffs being the widow and son and daughters and mother, legal heirs of the presumed to be deceased Gurdayal Singh, have become the owners in possession of the estates left by the deceased whatsoever and situated any where throughout the India including the movable properties if any in the name of deceased Gurdayal Singh and hence the plaintiffs are entitled to deal with the estates and can furnish any kind of undertaking and conduct the proceedings as was to be furnished by the Gurdayal Singh now presumed as deceased and the plaintiffs are legally entitled to present themselves in the capacity as Gurdayal Singh, as he (Gurdayal Singh) has been declared as dead in legal sense, on the basis of evidence of every description oral as well as documentary.

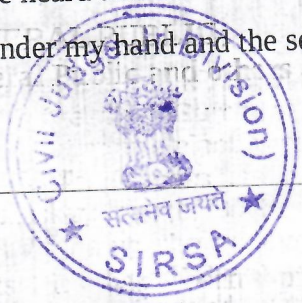
