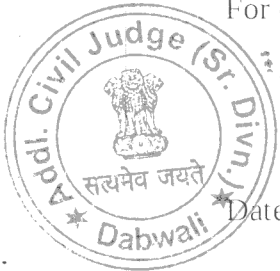

In above titled case, Suit for declaration to the effect that the plaintiff is owner and in possession of a house measuring 27 feet x 52(1/2) feet, bounded as East Sat Narain son of Diwan Chand, West Street, North Parkash Devi wife of Shri Prem Kumar, South Ashok Kumar son of Jagdish Rai son of Shri Ramditta Mal, bearing Municipal Council 743(old) Ward No. 5 and after that it was numbered as 176 Ward No. 5 and at present it bears new number as 311, situated in Ward No. 3, vide Assessment Register of Municipal Council Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa for the year 1994-95 to 1996-97 and 2010-11 to 2014-15, situated within the limits of Municipal Council, Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa, on the basis of will bearing No. 104 dated 10-11-1981 duly executed and got registered by Mahala Ram alias Hargopal son of Shri Dault Ram in favour of the plaintiff and Muṛti Devi and will bearing No. 105 dated 10-11-1981 duly executed and got registered by Babu Ram son of Shri Dault Ram in favour of the plaintiff and also by way of family settlement having arrived at between the plaintiff and defendants no. 2 and 3, but the revenue record and other govt. record as well as municipal record standing in the names of Babu Ram and Hargopal are wrong, against law and facts, null and void, void ab initio, ineffective and inoperative upon the rights of the plaintiff and is liable to be corrected in favour of the plaintiff accordingly AND further declaration to the effect that Babu Ram son of Shri Dault Ram is presumed to have died as he is not heard or seen by any person since 12-1-1982 and mandatory provision of seven years as required under the law stands completed and thus, he be declared as a dead person AND with a consequential relief of permanent injunction thereby restraining the defendants No. 2 and 3 from alienating or transferring the suit property and also from creating any bar or lien over the suit property and further restraining the defendants No. 2 and 3 from causing any type of interference into the possession of the plaintiff over the suit property, in any manner on the basis of evidence, oral as well as documentary of all kinds the defendant(s)/respondent(s) could not be served. It is ordered that defendant(s)/respondent(s) should appear in person or through counsel on 12-05-2020 at 10 a.m.
