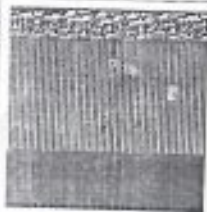

Suit for declaration to the effect that the impugned order endst.No.1756/ PLA dated 20.4.2021, vide which under the provisions of section 5 of the Punjab Cinema (Regulation) Act 1952, the defendant No.3 has granted the license to defendant No.1-Cine Ceara Cinemas, village Sikanerpur to continue or manage the cinematograph used in the said Cine Ceara Cinemas upto 5.12.2023, is wrong and incorrect against law and facts, against the mandatory provisions of section 5 of the Punjab Cinema (Regulation) Act 1952 and also against the order dated 19.3.2013 passed in CWP No.19629 of 2012 (O/M) by Honble Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh in which counsel of the defendant No.1 states that defendant No.1 will restrict the use of the theater only to showing 3D and 4D short duration movies and not the commercial motives and the impugned order same is inoperative, ineffective and not binding upon the rights of plaintiff in any manner and also against the principles of natural justice and the same is liable to be set-aside and quashed in toto and as a consequential relief of permanent injunction, restraining the defendants from implementing the impugned order 20.4.2021, in any manner further from giving license, No Objection Certificate, permission for setting up or commencing video, cinema, commercial cinema, on the basis of evidence of every description --oral as well as documentary

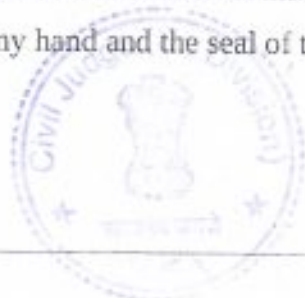
