



Indian army defuses 234 IEDs, landmines

Delhi: More than 234 types of Improvised Explosive Devices (IEDs) and landmines have been detected and defused over the last 24 hours, the Afghan Defence Ministry said on Sunday. "Afghan National Army engineering teams and bomb disposal units launched operations to clear landmines in different provinces since early Saturday. They found and defused 234 different IEDs and landmines," the Ministry said in a statement. Taliban militants and Islamic State (IS) extremist group's fighters have been using IEDs to make roadside bombs and landmines for targeting security forces, but the lethal home-made weapons also inflict casualties on civilians, Xinhua news agency reported. Finding and neutralising the weapons remains a challenge for Afghan security forces. IANS

UKIP sacks Bolton over racist remarks



London: Britain's far-right UK Independence Party has sacked **Henry Bolton** after weeks of controversy surrounding his girlfriend's racist messages targeting Prince Harry's fiancée Meghan Markle. Bolton, who had refused to resign amid mounting pressure from within the party, was sacked following a 63 per cent vote in favour of a no-confidence motion against the leader at an extraordinary general meeting (EGM) of the party in Birmingham. "I think it's going to be difficult to unite the party, what we have effectively had is a rejection of a new draft constitution, a reorganisation and indeed a new way of doing politics," said Bolton. He is thought to be considering legal action. PTI
