ORDER

Re: Situation arising due to outbreak of the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)

In continuation of Order No. 30/RG/Spl./Misc. dated 09.07.2020, Order No. 65/RG/Spl./Misc. dated 12.03.2021 and Order 89/RG/Spl./Misc. dated 14.07.2021 regarding computation of period of limitation in filing the cases; it is brought to the notice of all the Learned Advocates, Litigants and General Public that Hon'ble the Supreme Court has disposed of the "Miscellaneous Application No. 665 of 2021 in Suo-Moto Writ Petition (Civil) No. 3 of 2020 in RE: Cognizance for Extension of Limitation" vide judgement dated 23.09.2021 by issuing the following directions:-

- In computing the period of limitation for any suit, appeal, application or proceeding, the period from 15.03.2020 till 02.10.2021 shall stand excluded. Consequently, the balance period of limitation remaining as on 15.03.2021, if any, shall become available with effect from 03.10.2021.
- In cases where the limitation would have expired during II.the period between 15.03.2020 till 02.10.2021, notwithstanding the actual balance period of limitation remaining, all persons shall have a limitation period of 90 days from 03.10.2021. In the event the actual balance period of limitation remaining, with effect from 03.10.2021, is greater than 90 days, that longer period shall apply.
- The period from 15.03.2020 till 02.10.2021 shall also III.stand excluded in computing the periods prescribed under Sections 23 (4) and 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, Section 12A of the Commercial Courts Act, 2015 and provisos (b) and (c) of Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and any other laws, which prescribe period(s) of limitation for instituting proceedings, outer limits (within which the court or tribunal can condone delay) and termination of proceedings."
- The registry of this Hon'ble High Court and the Subordinate Courts in 2. the States of Punjab, Haryana and Union Territory, Chandigarh shall comply with the aforesaid directions for computation of period of limitation strictly.
