Certificate Type: Domain Validation  
RSA Signature Key: 2048 bit or more  
Hashing Algorithm: SHA 256 or more  
Certificate Duration: 1 year or more (if available)

Terms & Conditions:-

- 1 The rates should be F.O.R High Court premises, inclusive of all taxes, levies, GST etc.
- 2 The Certificates should be as per the specifications.
- 3 Payment will be made only after complete supply to the satisfaction of High Court and no advance payment will be made in any case.
