Suit for Declaration to the effect that Shri Dharam Singh alias Dharma son of Amar Singh son of Shri Jita Ram who was predecessor-in-interest of the plaintiffs has not been heard or seen for the last about 11 years since 24.08.2010 by those who have usually and generally seen him or heard of him and as per presumption of law as provided under the Indian Evidence Act, Shri Dharam Singh alias Dharma aforesaid has presumably died a civil death and accordingly after the civil death of Shri Dharam Singh alias Dharma, the plaintiffs being the only legal heirs of him have become the absolute and undisputed owners in cultivating possession, as per their respective shares of land measuring 9/106 share of land measuring 5 Kanals 6 Marlas comprising Khewat No. 215//188, Khatuni No. 284, Khasra No. 167//5 of 5-6 and 1/5th share of land measuring 113 Kanals 4 Marlas comprising Khewat No. 128//104, Khatuni No. 171 and 172 both situated at Village Masudpur, Tehsil Hansi, District Hisar as well as Plot measuring 7.33 Marlas ie. 215 Square Yards comprising Khewat No. 416/1, Khatuni No. 511, Khasra No. 64//26/3/1 situated at Mauja Rambir Colony and the plaintiffs are legally and lawfully entitled to get recorded/incorporated their names as owners in possession of the above land as well as all other lands and immovable properties as well as movable properties held in the name of Shri Dharam Singh alias Dharma of whatever type pursuant to his civil death and with mandatory injunction and direction to all concerned revenue offices/Banks/institutes etc. to transfer any other movable and immovable properties of Shri Dharam Singh alias Dharma in favour of the plaintiffs owing to his civil death. On the basis of evidence of all kinds oral as well as documentary of every description.
