Suit for declaration to the effect that plaintiffs are joint owner in possession of land measuring 15 kuala 08 marla comprised in Khewat No.93//74 Khatoni No. 148, Khasra No.116//10 (8-0) and as per fard Jamabandi for the 2015-16 of village Panihar chack, Distt. 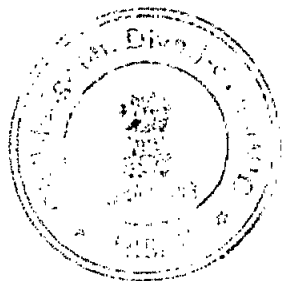
