The petitioner, respectfully submit as under:-

- 1- That the petitioner is permanent resident of Village Nathusari Kalan Tehsil and District Sirsa and is a peace loving and law abiding citizen of India.
- 2- That earlier the father in law of the petitioner namely Shri Jagdish son of Shri Sheokaran was the owner and in possession of land measuring 0 Kanal 13 Marlas comprised in Khewat No.1189 Khatuni No.1683 Khasra No.331/1(0-12) Gair Mumkin 338/1(0-1) Gair Mumkin Kitta 2 vide Jamabandi for the year 2021-22 read with mutation No.8420 dated 29-08-2024 situated at Village Nathusari Kalan Tehsil and District Sirsa and the revenue records were also continuing in his name as owner in possession of the same.
- 3- That vide transfer deed bearing No.2014/1 dated 21-08-2024 Shri Jagdish had transferred

on

the suit property in the name of the minor son of the petitioner namely Digraj Singh and had handed over the possession of the same to him at the spot. A mutation bearing No.8420 dated 29-08-2024 was also entered and sanctioned in the name of the minor son of the petitioner in this regard.

- 4- That the petitioner is the mother and natural guardian of minor Digraj Singh, who is owner in possession of the said property fully detailed and described in the heading of the petition situated at Village Nathusari Kalan District Sirsa.
- 5- That petitioner being mother of minor has no adverse interest to that of the minor in the present petition and as such she is filing the present petition on behalf of the minor.
- 6- That Digraj Singh is minor and has not attained majority till today.
- 7- That the petitioner intends to sell the suit land and the intended sale is in the better interest and welfare of the minor on the following grounds:-
 - (i) That the minor is not getting any income from the said land and minor can



not keep this share of the property which is not beneficial to him and as such the sale of share of minor in the said property is very much essential and necessary.

- (ii) That share of said property of the minor is fetching very good market price at present and there is no income from this property. If the said property of the minor is given to somebody else for use, then there is every possibility of unauthorized possession by the third person and it would be difficult for the minor as well as the petitioner to get vacated the same.
- (iii) That with the sale consideration of the share of said property, the petitioner intends to purchase some other useful property in the nearby vicinity in the name of the minor which is in the better interest and in the welfare of the minor or in the alternative the sale consideration shall be deposited in some nationalize bank in the name of

the minor in the shape of FDR and shall not misuse the same.

(iv) That the petitioner undertakes that she will abide by all the terms and conditions laid down by this Hon'ble court while granting the necessary permission to the petitioner to sell the property of the minor.

8- That the said property is situated in Village Nathusari Kalan District Sirsa and as such this Hon'ble court has got jurisdiction to try and entertain the present petition.

9- That the proper court fee has been affixed on the petition.

10- It is, therefore, prayed that the petition filed by the petitioner may kindly be accepted as prayed for in the petition and the necessary permission to sell the land of the minor fully detailed and described in the heading of the petition situated at village Nathusari Kalan District Sirsa, may kindly be granted to the petitioner, in the interest of justice. Any other relief in addition to the above, which this Hon'ble Court deems fit,

just and proper may also kindly be granted to
the petitioner, in the interest of justice.
