Suit for declaration to the effect that the plaintiff is owner in possession of agriculture land measuring 20 kanal 00 marla (including his own share as recorded in revenue record), detailed are as under i) Land measuring 13 kanal 8 marla, comprised in khewat no.361, Khatuni no.392, comprised in Sq. no.102, Killa no.1/2(5-8), 10(8-0), kitte 2. Land measuring 6 kanal 12 marla, being 132/212 share out of total land measuring 10 kanal 12 marla, comprised in khewat no.1121, Khatuni no.1209, Sq. no.102, Killa no.1/1(2-12), Sq. no.103, Killa no.5/2(4-0), 6/1(4-0), Kitta 3 as per sale deed no.1357 dated 30-05-1989 and the subsequent revenue record is wrong and incorrect and the same is liable to be corrected in favour of the plaintiff and against the defendants and mutation no.3803 entered and sanction 15-12-2003 on the basis of Civil suit no.715C of 1988, titled as Lal Singh etc. Versus Fauja Singh etc. passed by Shri Surender Kumar, Add. Civil Judge, Senior Division, Sirsa, decided on 22-02-1989 as well as the subsequent mutation bearing no.3890 entered and sanctioned on the basis of sale deed no.1357 dated 30-05-1989 is wrong and incorrect and as such the same are liable to be corrected alongwith subsequent revenue record And with a consequential relief of Permanent injunction restraining the defendants no.1 to 3 from causing interference into the suit property in any manner and also from restraining the defendants from dispossession of the plaintiff from the suit land and from causing damage to the seasonal crop standing in the suit land, on the basis of evidence of every kind i.e. oral as well as documentary.
