Suit for Declaration to the effect that the plaintiff along with their co mortgagees as per the revenue record continue to remain mortgagee in possession of the land bearing khewat no. 2/2 khatauni no. 4 khasra no. 5R/20,21,22 kite 3 measuring 19 Kanal 10 marla and khewat no. 67/65 khatauni no. 81 measuring 5R/18,19,23 12R/2,3,8,13/1 kite 7 total measuring 47 kanal 0 marlas khatauni no. 82 khasra no. 12R/19/1/1 kite 1 measuring 1 Kanal 18 marlas khatauni no. 83 khasra no. 19R/9/1/2 kite 1 measuring 1 kanal 18 marlas total kite 9 total land measuring 50 kanal 16 marlas situated in the revenue estate of village chanjeli Hb no. 354 Pathankot thesil and district Pathankot as entered in the jamabadi for the year 2017-18 and order passed by the collector in case no. 6 dated 11.06.2021 redeeming the mortgage in favour of defendant no. 1 to 3 regarding the aforesaid land vide order dated 24.02.2023 is liable to be set aside being illegal arbitrary based on conjectures and surmises are liable to be set aside and are ineffective qua mortgage rights of the plaintiff and their co-mortgagees/defendants 37d under section 12 of redemption of mortgages (punjab) Act 1913
B. In the alternative if the plaintiff is not found to be in possession or is dispossessed during the pendency of suit then for possession thereof.
C suit for permanent injunction restraining the defendants their agents assignees or representative from any way interfering in the peaceful possession of the land of the plaintiff and forcibly dispossessing the plaintiff raising any sort of construction or changing the nature or selling or alienating the land above detailed in head note A of the plaint unless in due course of law.
