Viva-Voce/Documents Checking for 60 posts of Reader (Legal) on the Establishment of the High Court

It is for the information of all concerned candidates that Viva-Voce/Documents checking for 60 Posts (48 Direct & 12 Departmental) of Reader (Legal) is scheduled to be held on 02.04.2026. The other necessary details shall be available on the E-admit card.

It is further informed that E-Admit Cards will be uploaded on the online link (<https://phconapp.formflix.org/>) on 25.03.2026. The candidates can download their E-Admit cards by filling the necessary details i.e. Registration Number and Date of Birth. All candidates are directed to carefully read and follow the instructions mentioned on the E-Admit Card. The candidates are advised to visit official website of the High Court (<https://highcourtchd.gov.in/>) for necessary updates.

It is further informed that the candidates shall be assessed during Viva-Voce on the basis of their General Awareness, Manners/Etiquette, Suitability for Job and Knowledge of Law.

Candidates must bring the following documents (in original), along-with one set of self-attested copies of these documents at the time of Viva-Voce/Documents checking:-

- i. Proof of Date of Birth (Matriculation Certificate showing Date of Birth/D.O.B Certificate issued by Registrar of Birth and Death).
- ii. Matriculation detailed Marks Sheet & certificate.
- iii. 10+2 detailed Marks Sheet & certificate indicating that the candidate has secured atleast 60% marks in English.
- iv. Proof of LL.B. Degree from a recognized University, detailed Marks Sheets (DMC) of LL.B. for all years & other qualification certificates which have been mentioned in the online application.
- v. Proof of category for Reserved Category candidates i.e. SC/ST/BC and Ex-Servicemen. In case, candidate belongs to BC Category, he/she must bring his/her latest BC Certificate along with duly filled/signed Annexure 'I' of advertisement. The candidates belonging to SC/ST/BC Category of Punjab, Haryana and U.T. Chandigarh must also bring their domicile certificate. Ex-Servicemen candidates shall have to bring self-attested complete copy of their discharge book along with its original.
- vi. Candidates who had applied for direct posts of Reader (Legal) and are working in Government Departments/ Semi-Government Departments/ Corporations/ Boards shall have to bring forwarding letter/No objection certificate on format appended with detailed online advertisement (Annexure 'II') issued by respective Head of their Departments.
- vii. Candidates of District Courts of Punjab, Haryana & UT Chandigarh applying for Departmental posts shall have to produce Forwarding Letter/No objection certificate on format appended with detailed online advertisement (Annexure 'III') issued by the District and Sessions Judge of the Session Division, where the candidate is presently posted.
- viii. Candidates must bring all relevant documents/Annexures as mentioned in Para 7 of the Advertisement.

If a candidate fails to produce his/her original Certificates/copies or fails to appear for Viva-Voce/documents checking on the date fixed, it may result in cancellation of his/her candidature for the posts of Reader (Legal).
