

Hon'ble the Chief Justice has been pleased to order that during the ensuing spell of Baisakhi Break, 2026, Anticipatory Bail Applications, Cases relating to Life and Liberty (Protection matter of Runaway Couples), Caveat Applications u/s 148-A CPC and 'any other Urgent Matter' as may be permitted by Hon'ble the Senior most Vacation Judge through Registry; will be entertained on **13.04.2026 and 15.04.2026.**

Habeas Corpus Petitions shall be entertained from **11.04.2026 to 15.04.2026.**

1. After Division Bench cases (if any), Hon'ble Judges sitting in Division Bench will also sit singly and take up Single Bench (Civil & Criminal) motion cases.
2. **Mentioning:**  
Requests for mentioning in any type of matter for listing on the same day or next Court working day including Division Bench matters will be made

before Hon'ble the Senior most Vacation Judge during the Baisakhi Break only on Court Working days i.e. 13.04.2026 and 15.04.2026 .

**3. Filing:**

No filing except Anticipatory Bail Applications, Protection matter of Runaway Couples, Caveat Application u/s 148-A CPC and 'cases in which mentioning for listing the case during Baisakhi Break has been allowed' by Hon'ble the Senior most Vacation Judge will be accepted on 13.04.2026 and 15.04.2026.

No E-filing except Anticipatory Bail Applications, Protection matter of Runaway Couples, Caveat Application u/s 148-A CPC and 'cases in which mentioning for listing the case during Baisakhi Break has been allowed' received during the period from 11.04.2026 to 15.04.2026 will be scrutinized by the registry.

However, Habeas Corpus Petitions will be entertained without any mentioning during the Baisakhi Break from 11.04.2026 to 15.04.2026.

**4. Listing:**

(i) Anticipatory Bail Applications and Protection Matters of Runaway Couples filed/re-filed upto 12'o clock during the Baisakhi Break will be listed after a gap of one working day.

All the Anticipatory Bail Applications and Protection Matters of Runaway Couples filed through e-filing and where print-out/original paper book will be submitted till 4:00 p.m. after approval will also be listed after a gap of one working day.

(ii) All the cases adjourned for the period from 11.04.2026 to 15.04.2026 will be shifted through NIC for 16.04.2026, unless specifically ordered to be listed during Baisakhi Break.

However, all the Hon'ble Special Division/Single Bench matters adjourned for the period from 11.04.2026 to 15.04.2026 will be shifted through NIC for 17.04.2026, respectively, unless specifically ordered to be listed during Baisakhi Break.

(iii) Habeas Corpus Petitions, Protection Matters of Runaway Couples, Parole/Premature Release, Bail Applications and Applications for Suspension of Sentence (*including Subsequent Bail Applications and Subsequent Applications for Suspension of Sentence filed by the same*

*accused*) adjourned for the period 11.04.2026 to 15.04.2026 will be listed for the date so adjourned or on next court working day, if the said date is a gazetted holiday.

- (iv) The Applications in Decided Cases will only be listed subject to the availability of the same composition of Hon'ble Judge(s) who had decided the earlier Bail Application or main case, if available during the Baisakhi Break roster.
